We share information about our ministries by phone, email, and through our website and Facebook page. If you are not connected, then you just may miss out!

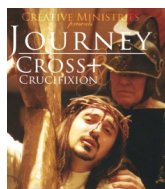

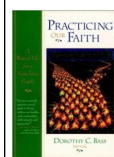
Today Is the First Sunday in Lent!
