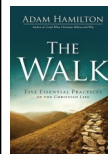

Lunch will be provided by the Middle and High School Youth Group as a fundraiser for their sponsored Compassion International child from Togo, Constantine Kayissan.



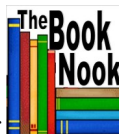
Lent Study Begins Sunday, March 8th

“Transformation”

Key Scriptures:

“And he (Jesus) was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him.”

Matthew 17:2-3

“The glory of the Lord settled on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; on the seventh day he called to Moses out of the cloud ... Moses entered the cloud, and went up on the mountain.”

Exodus 24:16, 18

What is significant or stands out for you in the transformation experienced by Moses when receiving the covenant from God on Mt. Sinai?

What is significant or stands out for you in the events surrounding the transfiguration of Jesus?
